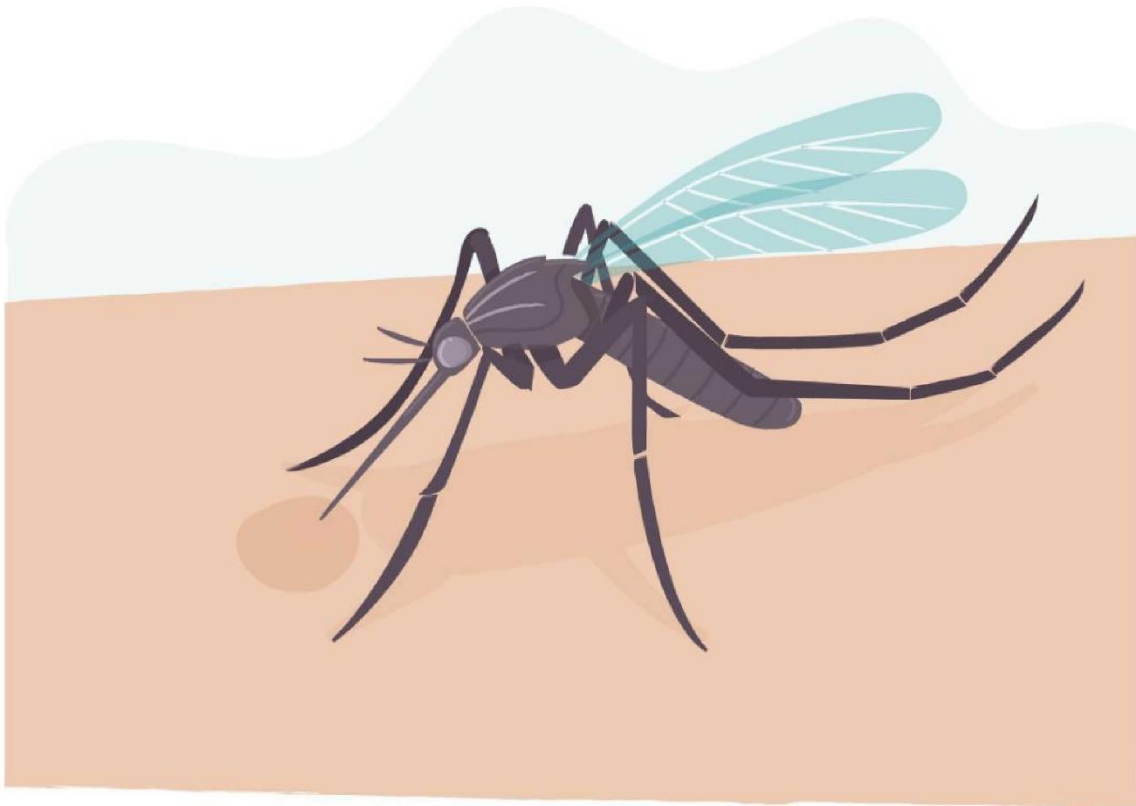




## **DENGUE: JUST THE FACTS**
