SUPPLEMENTAL

NOTE: This is NOT an official report, but provided as a brief summary of data shared during the GBHPC rescheduled June 2023 monthly meeting, held on July 6, 2023, via Zoom.

Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) Timestamp: 10:26:52

Data since start (June, 2022) through 05Jul23

Activations:

- 148 Total
- 72 (49%) via 988
- 36 (24%) via 911
- 40 (27%) via other
 - Clients/consumers, Lead Providers, Patient Registration, TOHGE

Activation Levels:

- 103 (70%) Level 3
 - MCRT responds alone
- 25 (17%) Level 2
 - MCRT responds as Lead with First Responder
- 13 (9%) Level 1
 - First Responder responds as Lead with MCRT

Purpose of Activation:

- 82 (55%) Suicidal / Homicidal Ideation, self-harm in progress
- 49 (33%) Mental Health crises
 - Psychosocial stressors, relational issues, PTSD
- 18 (12%) Unable to assess
 - Escaped activation point
 - Already in transport to precinct or hospital

Contributing Factors:

- 80 (54%) Multiple psychosocial stressors (issues with relationships/family)
- 34 (23%) Non-compliant with medications
- 34 (23%) Substance or alcohol related issues

Outcomes:

- 58 (39%) stabilized at response site
- 50 (34%) linked to Crisis Stabilization Unit (brought to GBHWC for further in-patient care)
- 40 (27%)
 - Checked in to hospital
 - Transported to precinct
 - Not at response site / activation point

Additional Notables:

- Transportation statistics
 - 59 total transport needed
 - 42 (71%) MCRT provided transport to GBHWC or GMH
 - 14 (24%) MCRT requested first responder transport
 - 3 (5%) transported via non-first responder, third party, family member
- Average response time: 21.9 minutes
 - Optimal response time under 1 hour
