The Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (the GBHWC) is soliciting proposals for professional services from Guam non-profit organizations to provide outpatient and intensive outpatient substance treatment for adolescent males and females that are funded by annual local appropriation (10 GCA Section 86109a) and federal funds (CFDA No. 93.959, SAMHSA Substance Abuse Prevention & Treatment Block Grant). The GBHWC identified evidence-based models and best practices must be utilized to provide such services.

All proposals must be submitted only by U.S. Mail, courier, or hand delivery and must be addressed to the Director, Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center. Electronic mail (email) is unacceptable.

The GBHWC shall have the right to reject all proposals or offers that have been submitted in response to this RFP, and/or may cancel this RFP at any time if the Director determines such to be in the interest of the GBHWC and/or for whatever reason allowed by law and/or regulation, and/or for whatever reason whatsoever.
