Formerly Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (GBHWC) is soliciting proposals to provide management and operations of a Drop-In Program, the Enrichment Center, Support Employment program, and Peer Mentorship for individuals with serious mental illness who are homeless or at imminent risk for homelessness. The Sagan Mami Programs is funded by federal funds (SAMHSA Mental Health Block Grant-CFDA No. 93.958; and Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness Grant, CFDA No. 93.150).

Request for Proposal (RFP) packages are available for public inspection at www.dmhsa.guam.gov or a hard copy is available for pickup at the Director's Office, located on the First Floor, 790 Governor Carlos G. Camacho Road, Tamuning, Guam during the weekdays except holidays, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Only proposals from organizations considered local public or non-profit organization will be accepted. The deadline for **receipt** of proposals is not later than **12 Noon, Monday August 26, 2013**, Guam Standard Time. All interested parties must register with the Director's Office in order to receive any amendment or relative correspondence regarding the RFP.

GBHWC shall have the right to reject all proposals or offers that have been submitted in response to this RFP, and/or may cancel this RFP at any time if the Director determines such to be in the interest of GBHWC or if allowed by law or regulation.
