POLICY:

Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (GBHWC) follows best practice principles in the handling of medication and shall maintain all Pharmacy service areas in a manner consistent with infection control.

DEFINITIONS:

<u>Medication Handling</u>: The manipulation of medications in order to dispense and administer them.

PROCEDURE:

A. General Guideline

- 1. It is important to carefully read the label or other printed instructions issued with medications.
- 2. The ordered doses (quantities) should be measured accurately and never estimated. A measuring glass or spoon marked in milliliters, ounces, or both should be used.
- 3. In giving a dose of medicine, it is necessary to know to whom it is to be given, what has to be given, when it has to be given, and the prescribed amount.
- 4. The cover must never be left off the container because a necessary property may evaporate, the drug may become dangerously concentrated, or it may absorb moisture from the air and become difficult to handle or dilute.
- 5. The drug storage compartment must be kept locked.

B. Infection Control

- 1. Universal precautions shall be practiced whenever the situation warrants.
- 2. All personnel shall wash their hands before handling any medication.
- 3. Whenever possible, unit dose medication shall be provided, especially for injectable solutions.
- 4. All equipment and glassware shall be cleaned before and after use.
- 5. Pharmacy counters shall be wiped down each day.
- 6. All refrigerators shall be kept clean and maintain proper refrigeration temperatures.
