    - iii. 10% unable to assess due to consumer elopement
  - b. Contributing Factors
    - i. 27% alcohol and substance use
    - ii. 21% medication non-compliance
    - iii. 52% other
  - c. Crisis stabilization dispositions
    - i. 63% home stabilization
    - ii. 30% linked to CSU
    - iii. 7% other
  - d. Transport
    - i. 75% MCRT
    - ii. 20% first responder
  - e. Average Response Time: time of activation to the scene
    - i. 23 minutes
