

988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline Phone Services in Guam Fully Restored and Operational

[Tamuning, Guam] – The Guam Behavioral Health & Wellness Center (GBHWC) announces that the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline phone services in Guam have been fully restored and are now operating at normal capacity. Individuals calling or texting 988, or accessing chat via 988lifeline.org, can once again expect uninterrupted crisis support.

Recent telecommunication network disruptions have been successfully resolved. The 988 Lifeline remains a vital, free, and confidential resource available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for anyone experiencing emotional distress, suicidal thoughts, substance use crises, or mental health challenges. Community members are also reminded that the Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) services can be accessed by dialing 988. Individuals needing an in-person, community-based crisis response are encouraged to call 988 to request MCRT assistance.

GBHWC appreciates the community's patience during the temporary interruption and reaffirms its commitment to ensuring reliable access to crisis services across Guam.
