No. 1:	<p>Question: "For the number of youth served, is it 300 total at the end of 3 years? Is this a cumulative total inclusive of all 3 organizations? Or is it 100 per year from 3 organizations?"</p> <p>Answer: Please refer to Section III A. 2.a., Page 17.</p>
No. 2:	<p>Question: "Is the needs assessment only capturing our selected target group within the selected setting? For example, youth 11-17 in school based settings? Or is it an overall community needs assessment?"</p> <p>Answer: Please refer to Section III. C. regarding what offerors should include in the proposal.</p>
No. 3:	<p>Question: "Is there a resource or listing available of EBPs that have been "evaluated as effective in Guam" specifically as required by the RFP? Where can we find the evaluation results and/or research studies of each of these EBPs to determine the fit to our program design and population?"</p> <p>Answer: The template for the strategic action plan on Page 104 is incorrect and should read, <i>"The proposed evidence-based program must be recognized by SAMHSA and appropriate for the populations(s) of focus."</i> An amendment will be issued and posted on our website.</p>
No. 4:	<p>Question: "The RFP requires the offeror to select an implementation setting, however it also requires taking referrals from a variety of community providers and partners. Can you clarify the expectations of the referral process?"</p> <p>Answer: Status quo. No clarification is needed.</p>
