Please note the questions received from a prospective offeror on July 2, 2021 and the answers given by Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center.

No. 1:	<p><b>Question:</b> “What is the extent of the subgrantees involvement in the several state grant evaluation for PFS?”</p> <p><b>Answer:</b> PEACE PFS Partners are required to include as part of the project team a Data Analyst who will be charged with performing evaluation activities for the organization, including survey development and validation (Page 19 of RFP). This person will work closely with the Program Evaluator and PEACE Research Analyst in collecting, analyzing and reporting the following data:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pre- and post-test, using the IRB-approved tool from GBHWC</li><li>• Pre- and post-test survey, using the tool provided by the Partner’s selected EBP</li><li>• Monthly progress reports, which includes indicators/questions required for national cross-site evaluation</li></ul>
No. 2:	<p><b>Question:</b> “Given the already established selection of two other subgrantees and their existing budgets, how much specifically is available for this specific RFP?”</p> <p><b>Answer:</b> To maintain fairness in the procurement process for this subgrant, we are only at liberty to disclose this amount during budget negotiation. The total amount for all subgrants is \$288,000, which will be divided equitably based on population distribution among GDOE elementary, middle and high school students. At the time this grant was written, middle school students account for 25-30% of GDOE’s population.</p>
