Professional Services for Residential Rehabilitation
Substance Treatment for Adolescent Males and Females
GBHWC RFP 01-2020

Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (GBHWC) is soliciting proposals from Guam non-profit organizations for professional services to provide 24- hour residential rehabilitation substance treatment for adolescent males and females that are funded by annual local appropriations (10 GCA Section 86109) and federal funds (CFDA No. 86109, SAMHSA Substance Abuse Prevention & Treatment Block Grant). Consumers of the service shall be primarily assisted with acquiring relapse prevention skills to support abstinence. GBHWC identified evidence-based models and best practices must be utilized to provide such services:

Electronic mail (email) IS NOT acceptable for the proposals.

GBHWC shall have the right to reject all proposals or offers that have been submitted in response to this RFP, and/or may cancel this RFP at any time if the Deputy Director determines such to be in the interest of GBHWC or if allowed by law or regulation.
